
This letter is being translated and will be distributed to units identified as Chinese, Danish, Dutch, Finnish, French, German, Hungarian, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mongolian, Norwegian, Portuguese, Russian, Samoan, Spanish, Swedish, Thai, Tongan, and Ukrainian. Distribution in these languages will be complete within two weeks. New Guidelines for Finding Lost Members

Prevention

On December 1, 2012, the MLS system will be modified to require the completion of nine locating steps *before* a member's record can be transferred to the address unknown file.

The following image shows what the computer screen listing these steps will look like:



The purpose of these steps is to increase the likelihood of locating a member who has moved without leaving a new address.

<u>Identification</u>

On December 1, 2012, the MLS system will separately identify member records that are transferred to a ward or branch from the address unknown file. The following image shows what this MLS report will look like:

Identifying these records separately on the MLS report is intended to encourage bishops to designate full-time and ward missionaries, or others, to visit, teach, and rescue these souls. Many members whose records are transferred from the address unknown file have un-baptized spouses and children, and this provides an opportunity for missionary work.
